

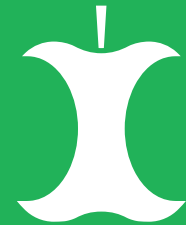


Yes:

Packed in a newspaper or paper bag and drained

- Food leftovers
- Fruit and vegetable peels
- Fish bones
- Egg shells and shredded egg cartons
- Coffee grounds and tea leaves with filter papers
- Tissues such as paper towels and napkins
- Plant parts and dried flowers

Biowaste



No:

- Liquid waste
- Waste that cannot decompose
- Feces or diapers
- Mulch, sand or cat litter
- Sticks, twigs or raking waste
- Bones (small bones, e.g. chicken bones will work)
- Canned food with glass or metal packaging



Any packaging that contains residues of dangerous substances and pressurised packaging (e.g. paint, chemicals, oils, medicines, hairspray) must be taken to your local hazardous waste collection point.
