- Corrugated cardboard boxes
- Cartons, e.g. milk and juice cartons
- Cardboard containers for ready meals, packaging for dry products
- Cartons for dry products, e.g. cereal and biscuit packets
- Paper bags
- Pizza boxes, egg cartons
- Disposable tableware made of cardboard
- Toilet and kitchen roll tubes
- Wrapping paper, e.g. copy paper wrappings
- Cardboard carriers for beverages, e.g. six-packs and cases
